




# How to make a pond dipping net



### You will need:

- wire coat hanger
- · pair of tights




- scissors

- strong duct tape





- · garden cane
- · white plastic tray




Out the legs off a pair of tights where the tops of the thighs would be. The the loose ends together in a tight knot to form the net.










Remember to return creatures to their homes.

· wear old clothes and wellies




 Cover all cuts and scratches with waterproof plasters




- · go with a friend, and take a responsible adult too
- · take a field guide if you have one



· take a net, shallow tray or washing up bowl and a jam jar



- 1) Put a small amount of pond water into your tray/bowl
- 2 Dip your net in the pond and pull it through the water - try a figure of 8
- 3 Empty your net into the tray/bowl and look carefully (some creatures are very Small)














# How to build a miniature raft



### You will need:

· large, straight sticks



· string or twine




large leaf
(or newspaper)



· wooden lolly sticks

Break sticks to roughly the same length, and lay them side by side.




Watch out for knobbly bits - avoid too many gaps.

3 Glue wooden lolly sticks over the top of the string lines and leave to dry.




2 Tie string around the end of the first stick and tie a tight knot. Thread the string under and around the end of each stick in turn, and tie off on last stick.



Repeat on the other side.

4 Add a thinner stick for a mast - push between middle sticks and glue or drill a hole for it. Use a large leaf or square of newspaper for a sail.
